Nabaztag:tag, the multipurpose Internet-connected Rabbit

Picture yourself at home. In a corner of the room, on a coffee table, a shelf or a desk, a **pretty little white Rabbit**, knee-high to a grasshopper, has made his abode. He says nothing, just sits there unobtrusively, silently **flashing funny little luminous animations on his tummy**. You glance at Nabaztag and, through the colour of his lights, effortlessly discover that the NASDAQ is down but that tomorrow's weather is sunny, and that over there, between Maillot and La Chapelle, the traffic on the Paris ring road is flowing smoothly.

Suddenly, **your Nabaztag comes alive and begins talking and moving his ears**. He tells you that the important e-mail you were expecting has just arrived, he reads out breaking news from The Times website like you asked him to, or he breaks into "I Just Called to Say I Love You", a musical declaration of love sent by a special someone. Or perhaps Nabaztag is just enjoying a few relaxing Tai Chi exercises.

That's Nabaztag: a companion who is often discreet (but loud when he has to be), adaptable and versatile; **in turn useful, funny and poetic, or all of these at once**. A magical presence in your real world.

Nabaztag isn't only a Rabbit. He's also a **new kind of technological object**.

Nabaztag has just one wire, for electrical power. But his true umbilical cord is cordless: he connects to the Internet through a broadband connection and Wi-Fi Access Point.

Adopt a Rabbit, set him up in your home. Log on to violet.net, give him a name and select all the things you want him to do for you.

Nabaztag lives his quiet life, while **continually monitoring the internet to provide the services you have requested**, accomplish the tasks you have assigned, give you real-time info and transmit messages from your friends. He's usually tame, but occasionally voices his own opinions and moods.

Best of all, because Nabaztag feeds off the Internet and **because the Internet is boundless, there are no limits to what he can do or could do tomorrow.**

Features

- Blinks, moves his ears, talks, plays music
- Reads out loud written texts in 32 languages
- Obeys spoken commands
- Detects and reacts to the presence of a Nano:ztag or any other object featuring a [RFID Ztag](#)
- Feeds off the Internet. Transmits, reacts, obeys what's on the Web
- Gives short news with speech & colour-coded lights (Weather, Markets...)
- Reads out loud real time news from any Website (RSS)
- Reads, sings and dances messages and songs sent by your friends over the Net
- Sings and dances MP3 tunes sent by your friends over the Net
- Chat with other Rabbit owners through voice, music and ear movements
- Ability to create your own content channels and applications (API)
- Ever-expanding set of free services and content
- Easy to program through a Web interface
- Connects to your Wi-Fi network and works even when your computer is powered off
- And much, much more...

What does he do?

The choice of services and content is ever-expanding. The following list is purely indicative and non-exhaustive. All services can be used free of charge.

RSS feed text-to-speech

In real time, or whenever you like, Nabaztag can read out news as it appears on the Web

Podcasts

Nabaztag plays back your Podcasts at the time you schedule

Internet radio

Nabaztag plays your favourite Webradios at the time you schedule, or whenever you ask him with a voice command

Weather forecast

Nabaztag talks about the weather all the time, with blinking lights or spoken newsflashes

Financial markets

In real time, Nabaztag keeps you informed of market trends with his blinking lights

Email alert

Nabaztag can warn you when a specific message has arrived

Messaging

Exchange spoken or musical messages with your friends and other Rabbit owners

Rabbit moods

Nabaztag occasionally expresses his mood, or does his Tai-Chi exercises

Alarm clock

Get a morning wake-up call with your favourite tune or radio station

Talking clock

On the top of every hour, Nabaztag tells you the time in a different way

Ear talk

Move your Rabbit's ears to remotely move the ears on a friend's Nabaztag

Recognizes everyday objects fitted with RFID Ztamps and triggers services

Sends messages, plays music and speech, sends data

Reads out kid's books fitted with Ztamps (available separately)

Programs and performs services assigned to the Nano:ztag Micro-Rabbit
